A. Financial Control & Visibility

- Month end reporting takes longer than it should and still feels unreliable.
- Management reports depend heavily on spreadsheets and manual adjustments
- Profitability by customer, product, job, or channel is hard to see in real time
- Forecasting and cashflow planning require significant rework each period
- Finance spends more time compiling data than analysing it

INSIGHT

When finance becomes a reporting factory, leadership loses decision velocity

B. Systems & Data Architecture

- Core systems (finance, inventory, CRM, payroll) are poorly integrated
- The same data is entered or reconciled multiple times
- Different teams trust different numbers
- Excel is being used as a "system of record"
- Reporting logic lives in individual spreadsheets rather than the system

INSIGHT

Data silos don't just create inefficiency, they create internal debate instead of action.

C. Compliance & Risk

- Payroll and compliance reporting feels stressful or fragile
- Adjustments are made late in the process to "make it work"
- Audit trails are difficult to follow
- Security, access control, and data governance are inconsistent
- The business relies on legacy systems that are hard to patch or secure

INSIGHT

As compliance becomes real time and data driven, integrity matters more than intent.

D. Scalability & Growth

- Growth has increased complexity rather than clarity
- Adding new products, customers, pricing rules, or locations feels painful
- System performance or usability degrades as transaction volumes grow
- Operational processes rely on workarounds rather than standard flows
- Leadership worries that growth will "break" current systems

INSIGHT

The right ERP should make growth part of business as usual, not chaotic.

E. People & Capability

- Key system knowledge sits with one or two people
- Training is informal or inconsistent
- New staff struggle to understand "how things really work"
- Business users see systems as obstacles rather than enablers
- Previous system changes were disruptive or poorly adopted

INSIGHT

ERP success is a people capability issue as much as a technology one.
